Program Overview:

The Recovery House at The College of New Jersey is a substance free living and learning community that brings a small group of students together in a College House close to campus. Residents will live with a graduate advisor who will provide resources and support.

Program Eligibility:

To apply for the Recovery House, you must meet certain eligibility requirements:

- 3 months sobriety
- on-campus interview with recovery community students and/or staff

House Details:

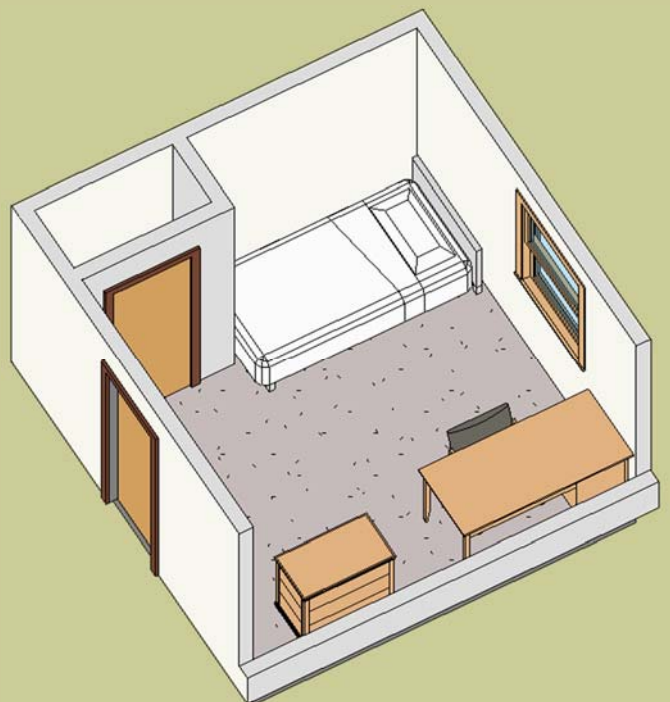
The house is made up of a few singles and a double room (room assignments will be determined after the application period has ended).

House amenities include a living room, full kitchen with dining room, laundry, ample driveway parking, porch and outdoor space.

This is a college owned house, and includes maintenance, utilities, wireless internet and cable.

Each room comes with:

- Twin X-Long Bed
- Desk with chair
- Dresser
- Carpeted floor



Single rooms are approximately 11ft. x 11 ft.
